11. How will clubs and members participate? ***work with locally, greater flexibility***

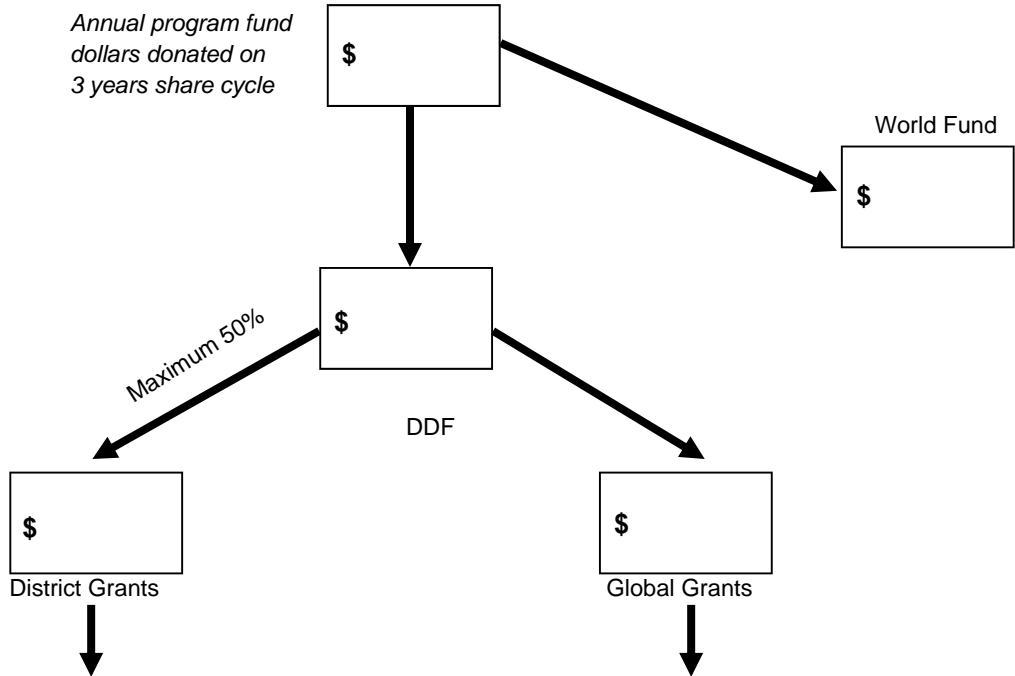
12. Are there limitations to the program – ***only limitation is the limitation Rotarians put on the program by limiting their contributions!!***
